

JAPANESE MAPLE INFORMATION SHEET

ACER JAPONICUM ACONITIFOLIUM: FERN LEAF, FULL MOON MAPLE. THE BRIGHT GREEN NEW LEAVES HAVE SMALL RED FLOWERS IN THE SPRING. THE FALL COLOR IS RED AND ORANGE TINGED WITH PURPLE AND YELLOW. 15'H X 8'W.

ACER JAPONICUM AO JUTAN: FERN LEAF, FULL MOON MAPLE. A SLIGHTLY CASCADING SPREADER WITH LARGE GREEN, DEEPLY DISSECTED LEAVES. THE FALL COLOR IS VIBRANT GOLD, ORANGE, RED AND PURPLE. 2'H X 5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER JAPONICUM GREEN CASCADE: FERN LEAF, FULL MOON MAPLE. IT MAY NEED STAKING WHEN YOUNG TO ENCOURAGE THE WEEPING HABIT. THE RICH GREEN LEAVES ARE SET OFF BY RED FLOWERS IN THE SPRING. IT TURNS BRILLIANT YELLOW TO ORANGE/RED IN THE FALL WITH RED SAMARAS. 10' X 10'.

ACER JAPONICUM ITAYA: A VIGOROUS, UPRIGHT GROWER WITH A BROAD CANOPY THAT SLOWS AND FORMS AN ATTRACTIVE SMALL TREE WITH AGE. THE HUGE GREEN LEAVES TURN BLAZING YELLOW, ORANGE AND RED IN THE FALL. 12'H X 5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER JAPONICUM MEIGETSU: VIGOROUS AND UPRIGHT GROWING WITH ROUND GREEN SUMMER LEAVES THAT TURN BRILLIANT ORANGE AND RED IN THE FALL. 10'H X 5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER JAPONICUM VITIFOLIUM: THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS COPPERY ORANGE AND TURNS A DEEP GREEN IN THE SUMMER. IN THE FALL THE LEAVES ARE SCARLET, YELLOW AND ORANGE. VIGOROUS. 18'H X 18'W.

ACER PALMATUM ALPENWEISS: UPRIGHT AND VASED SHAPE HABIT. THE SPRING LEAVES ARE WHITE AND GREEN VARIEGATION WITH PINK EDGES. FALL COLOR IS YELLOW, ORANGE AND RED. 10'H X 3'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM AO SHIME: A UNIQUE GREEN LINEARILOBUM WITH 3, 5 OR 7 LOBED LEAVES. THE NARROW SPRING LEAVES BROADEN IN THE SUMMER. FALL COLOR IS ORANGE TO GOLD BECOMING YELLOW. 5-7'H X 5-7'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM AOBA JO: A HARDY AND VIGOROUS DWARF GREEN WITH A MOUNDING HABIT. THE FALL COLOR IS YELLOW ORANGE CHANGING TO SCARLET. 3'H X 3'W.

ACER PALMATUM AOYAGI GAWA: THE LIGHT GREEN LEAVES WITH LONG NARROW LOBES TURN BRIGHT YELLOW IN THE FALL. THE WINTER BRANCHES AND STEMS TURN CORAL-YELLOW-GREEN. 6'H X 3'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM ARIADNE: VERY NICE GREEN RETICULATION (VEINS). THE SPRING COLOR IS ORANGE-PINK CHANGING TO DEEPER ORANGE IN THE SUMMER AND ORANGE-RED IN THE FALL. 8'H X 8'W.

ACER PALMATUM ASAHI ZURU: THE NAME MEANS "RISING SUN". THE SPRING VARIATION IS CREAMY WHITE WITH PINK THAT BECOMES MORE INTENSE WITH AGE. THE SPRING BARK ALSO HAS PINK STRIATIONS. A SPREADING HABIT TO 14'H.

ACER PALMATUM ATROLINEARE: A RED LINEARILOBUM WITH FINE THREAD LIKE LEAVES. THE GROWTH HABIT IS OFTEN VASE SHAPED AND OPEN TOPPED. THE FALL COLOR VARIES BETWEEN ORANGE AND RED. 6-8'H X 5-7'W.

ACER PALMATUM ATROPURPUREUM: FINELY DIVIDED RED LACY LEAVES FADE TO LIGHT GREEN IN THE SUMMER. FALL COLOR IS BEAUTIFUL GOLDEN, ORANGE OR RED. UPRIGHT GROWING 20'HW.

ACER PALMATUM BABY GHOST: BROAD AND UPRIGHT GROWING WITH GREENISH PURPLE LEAVES. THE FALL COLOR IS FANTASTIC ORANGE RED. 10'HW.

ACER PALMATUM BABY LACE LEXINGTON: RARE! THE THICK, LONG LEAVES ARE ORANGE RED IN THE SPRING, MEDIUM GREEN IN THE SUMMER AND BRIGHT ORANGE RED IN THE FALL. 3-5'HW.

ACER PALMATUM BENI HAGOROMO: THE FEATHERY LEAVES ARE DISSECTED TO THE BASE. SPRING COLOR IS BRILLIANT RED CHANGING TO GREEN WITH RED TINGES IN THE SUMMER AND ORANGE AND RED IN THE FALL. 12'H.

ACER PALMATUM BENI KOMACHI: THE NAME MEANS "RED BEAUTIFUL LITTLE GIRL". THE SPRING COLOR IS RED QUICKLY CHANGING TO DARK PURPLE. THE CRINKLED LEAVES TURN DARK GREEN EDGED IN PURPLE IN THE SUMMER AND BRIGHT CRIMSON WITH DEEP RED CENTERS IN THE FALL. 5-7'H X 3-4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM BENI SCHICHIHENG: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE BRIGHT GREEN EDGED IN PURE WHITE WITH ROSE PINK AND ORANGE UNDERTONES TURNING TO OUTSTANDING GOLD IN THE FALL. 12'HW.

ACER PALMATUM BENI YUBI GOHON: A SLOW GROWING, RED LINEARILOBUM THAT TURNS SCARLET IN THE FALL. GREAT FOR BONSAI. 5'HW.

ACER PALMATUM BLOODGOOD: ATTRACTIVE BURGUNDY RED FOLIAGE TURNS BRILLIANT SCARLET IN THE FALL. THE BLACKISH RED BARK HAS ATTRACTIVE WINTER INTEREST. 15-20'H X 15'W.

ACER PALMATUM BURGUNDY LACE: THE BRILLIANT BURGUNDY RED FINELY SERRATED LEAVES GIVE THE UPRIGHT GROWTH A GRACEFUL BRANCHING FORM. 10-12'HW.

ACER PALMATUM BUTTERFLY: THE GREEN LEAVES HAVE A BOLD SILVER EDGE WITH HINTS OF ROSE TURNING TO OUTSTANDING RED IN THE FALL. GROWS IN A VASE SHAPED HABIT. 12'HW.

ACER PALMATUM CHANTILLY LACE: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE GREEN WITH A PINK-RED OVERTONE. HARDY AND FAST GROWING, THE NEW SUMMER LEAVES HAVE A NICE RED CONTRAST. THE FALL COLOR IS CORAL-YELLOW. 4'X4' IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM CHITOSEYAMA: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE A SOFT BRICK RED CHANGING TO BRONZE THEN OLIVE GREEN IN THE SUMMER. THE FALL COLOR IS BRIGHT RED. 6-8'H X 8-10'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM CRIMSON QUEEN: A LOW BRANCHING DWARF WITH A DELICATE WEEPING EFFECT. THE CRIMSON COLOR HOLDS THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER CHANGING TO BRIGHT SCARLET IN THE FALL. 10'HW.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM EMERALD LACE: ONE OF THE FASTEST GROWING OF THE DISSECTUMS. THE LIME GREEN SPRING GROWTH HAS ORANGE MARGINS AND IS HEAT AND SUN TOLERANT. THE FALL COLOR IS RED, WHICH IS RARE FOR GREEN DISSECTUMS. 4-6'H X 7-9'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM EVER RED: A DWARF WITH A DELICATE WEEPING EFFECT. THE DEEP RED COLOR HOLDS THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER AND FALL. 10'HW.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM GARNET: THE RICH RED-ORANGE COLOR IS STRONGER IN THE SUN AND GREENER IN THE SHADE, CHANGING TO SCARLET IN THE FALL. A VIGOROUS, PENDULOUS SPREADING HABIT. 8-10'HW.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM GERMAINE'S GYRATION: A GREEN DISSECTUM WITH GREAT HEAT TOLERANCE. IT GROWS WIDER THAN TALL WITH SWIRLING BRANCHES IN DIFFERENT DIRECTIONS. IT FORMS A PLEASANT, FAIRLY SYMMETRICAL MOUND WHEN MATURE. THE FALL COLOR IS GOLDEN YELLOW TURNING TO ORANGE AND ALMOST RED. 4-5'H X 6-9'W IN 10 YRS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM GREEN HORNET: A PENDULOUS GROWER WITH ELEGANT LEAVES CASCADING INTO AN UMBRELLA SHAPE. SPRING AND SUMMER COLOR IS GREEN AND FALL COLOR IS BRIGHT RED. 4-6'H X 7-9'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM INABA SHIDARE: A GOOD MAPLE FOR HOTTER CLIMATES. THE SPRING LEAVES ARE DARK PURPLE, THEN REDDER TO BRONZE IN THE SUMMER. THE FALL COLOR IS USUALLY A BRIGHT FIERY RED. 4-6'H X 7-9'W.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM JEDDELOH ORANGE: THE NEW LEAVES EMERGE ORANGE-GREEN THEN TURN MOSTLY GREEN. THE FALL COLOR IS BRIGHT ORANGE. A STRONG WEEPING HABIT. 4'HW IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM LION HEART: A LARGE AND VIGOROUS UPRIGHT TREE WHEN YOUNG, SPREADING WITH AGE. THE BRIGHT RED SPRING COLOR TURNS BRONZE OR GREEN AND THE FALL COLOR IS BRILLIANT RED. 8-10'HW IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM MAYMONT: GREEN LEAVES TURN RED-ORANGE IN THE FALL. 3-6'H X 6-9'W.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM ORANGEOLA: THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS RED-ORANGE TURNING TO GREENISH PURPLE. IN THE FALL THE LEAVES TURN FROM RED TO BRILLIANT ORANGE. STRONGLY CASCADING AND PENDULOUS. 7'H X 10'W.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM PENDULUM JULIAN: A STRIKING DARK ORANGE DISSECTUM WITH GREEN BARK. THE NEW LEAVES ARE BRONZE GREEN WITH GREEN VEINS TURNING TO A DEEP PURPLE IN THE SUMMER. THE FALL COLOR IS VIVID CRIMSON-ORANGE. 6-10'H MOUNDING SHAPE.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM PINK LACE: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE CHARTREUSE WITH PINK EDGES TURNING MEDIUM GREEN IN THE SUMMER AND GOLD IN THE FALL. PREFERS PARTIAL SHADE. 3-5'H X 6-8'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM RARAFLORE: SPRING LEAVES ARE LIGHT ORANGE TURNING TO DEEP MAROON IN THE SUMMER AND ORANGE IN THE FALL. WEEPING HABIT. 6'HW.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM RED DRAGON: THE LEAVES ARE PURPLE AND DEEPLY DISSECTED CHANGING TO BRIGHT APPLE RED IN THE FALL. 7-8'H.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM RED SELECT: A PENDULOUS LACE LEAF WITH PURPLE SPRING FOLIAGE TURNING TO RED IN THE SUMMER AND BRILLIANT RED IN THE FALL. 8'HW.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM SEIRYU: CONSIDERED THE ONLY UPRIGHT GROWING DISSECTUM. FAST GROWING VASE SHAPED THAT GETS WIDER AND ROUNDER WITH AGE. THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS GREEN WITH A RED OR PINK TINGE TO THE MARGINS, FADING TO MEDIUM GREEN AND TURNING ORANGE-BURGUNDY IN THE FALL. 12-14'HW.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM SPRING DELIGHT: WEEPING AND MOUNDING WITH PALE GREEN EDGED IN RED SPRING LEAVES. SUMMER COLOR IS MEDIUM GREEN TO VIBRANT ORANGE IN THE FALL. 2-3'H X 4-5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM TAMUKEYAMA: THE NEW LEAVES ARE A RICH CRIMSON CHANGING TO PURPLE-RED IN THE SUMMER AND BRIGHT SCARLET IN THE FALL. HAS A BROADLY MOUNDING HABIT. 8-10'H X 10-12'W.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM VIRIDIS: THE MOST POPULAR WEEPING GREEN LACELEAF. THE SPRING COLOR IS GREEN CHANGING TO YELLOW, GOLD AND ORANGE-RED IN THE FALL. 5-10'H X 10-15'W.

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM WATERFALL: A FAST GROWER WITH BRIGHT GREEN SUMMER FOLIAGE THAT TURNS BRILLIANT GOLD WITH HINTS OF CRIMSON IN THE FALL. 8-12'H X 6-10'W.

ACER PALMATUM ELMWOODII: LIGHT LIME GREEN LEAVES IN THE SPRING TURN A MOSSY GREEN IN THE SUMMER WITH GREAT RETICULATION. FALL COLOR IS GOLDEN ORANGE. THIS TREE HAS BEEN DESCRIBED AS MULTI COLORED. 8-10'H X 4-6'W.

ACER PALMATUM EMPEROR: THE NEW GROWTH IS DEEP PURPLE RED AND IT HOLDS IT'S COLOR THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER BETTER THAN BLOODGOOD. THE NEW FOLIAGE ALSO EMERGES APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS AFTER MOST JAPANESE MAPLES, GIVING ADDED PROTECTION FROM LATE SPRING FROSTS. THE FALL COLOR IS CRIMSON. 18'H X 12'W.

ACER PALMATUM ENKAN: A FINE LINEARILOBUM WITH A COMPACT GROWTH HABIT. THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS DEEP WINE-RED STAYING RED INTO THE SUMMER AND ORANGE RED IN THE FALL. 5-7'H X 4-5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM FIREGLOW: VERY SIMILAR TO BLOODGOOD, BUT SMALLER GROWING. THE DEEP RED FOLIAGE IS SUN TOLERANT AND TURNS A LUMINESCENT PURPLE SCARLET TO CRIMSON IN THE FALL. 6-10'HW IN 10 YEARS, MAX AT 20'H X 15'W.

ACER PALMATUM FIRST GHOST: THE FOLIAGE IS NEARLY WHITE WITH GREEN VEINS AND RED LOBE TIPS IN THE SPRING. THE FALL COLOR INCLUDES YELLOW TO ORANGE. AFTERNOON SHADE IS PREFERRED. 7'H X 4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM GINSHI: THE LONG NARROW LEAF LOBES ARE RED IN THE SUMMER AND BRILLIANT CRIMSON IN THE FALL. 8'H X 4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM GRANDMA GHOST: THE SPRING COLOR IS AMBER, CREAM WHITE AND PALE GREEN WITH VIBRANT PINK VEINS. THE FALL COLOR IS RED AND GOLD. 8'H X 4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM GREEN FINGERS: THE NARROW, THREAD-LIKE LEAVES ARE DEEP GREEN IN THE SPRING AND SUMMER CHANGING TO BRILLIANT ORANGE IN THE FALL. GROWS ROUND AND SHRUB-LIKE. 6'H X 3'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM GWEN'S ROSE DELIGHT: THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS A BRIGHT CHERRY RED OR BRIGHT PINK WITH OLIVE GREEN. SOME OF THE PINK REMAINS THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER, CHANGING FROM RED TO ORANGE IN THE FALL. PREFERS AFTERNOON SHADE. 10-12'H X 6-8'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM HUBBS MON ZUKUSHI: THE ROUNDED GREEN LEAVES TURN TO ORANGE OR DEEP RED IN THE FALL. A VIGOROUS GROWER FORMING A FULL CANOPY. 10'H X 5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM HUBBS RED WILLOW: THE RICH DARK BURGUNDY LEAVES HAVE LONG NARROW LOBES GIVING THIS TREE A MISLEADING DELICATE APPEARANCE. IT IS ACTUALLY VERY TOUGH, ONE OF THE MOST TOLERANT OF HEAT AND SUN. THE WILLOWY SHAPE FORMS A ROUND TOPPED TREE. THE FALL COLOR IS FIERY ORANGE AND RED. 6-8'H X 5-6'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM HUPPS DWARF: NICE PINK TIPS ON THE NEW GREEN GROWTH TURN ORANGE AND RED IN THE FALL. A DENSE, COMPACT DWARF. 2-3'HW IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM ILARIAN: THE TINY GREEN LEAVES HAVE PINK AND WHITE VARIEGATION THAT CHANGE TO ORANGE IN THE FALL. 8'H X 4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM IRO IRO: THE SMALL GREEN STAR SHAPED LEAVES HAVE PINK AND WHITE VARIEGATION. GROWS INTO A DENSE, BUSHY TREE. 6'H X 3'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM JAPANESE SUNRISE: A FAST GROWER WITH BEAUTIFUL BARK THAT CAN BE YELLOW TO BRIGHT RED DEPENDING ON THE TIME OF YEAR AND AMOUNT OF SUNLIGHT. THE WINTER BARK TENDS TO BE VERY ORANGE. THE SMALL SPRING LEAVES ARE LIME GREEN CHANGING TO DARKER GREEN IN THE SUMMER AND NICE YELLOW IN THE FALL. 16-18'H X 10-12'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM KATSURA: THE SPRING COLOR IS VERY EYE CATCHING BECAUSE IT OCCURS BEFORE MOST MAPLES HAVE FOLIATED, BEING BRIGHT YELLOW TURNING TO GREEN IN THE SUMMER AND THEN BRILLIANT ORANGE AND YELLOW IN THE FALL. VASE SHAPED WHEN YOUNG, IT DEVELOPS INTO A ROUND TOPPED TREE WITH AGE. 10-12'H X 6-8'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM KI HACHIJO: THE BRIGHT GREEN SPRING LEAVES DARKEN INTO THE SUMMER AND CHANGE TO A WONDERFUL ORANGE AND GOLD IN THE FALL. FORMS A BEAUTIFUL ROUND TOPPED TREE USUALLY WIDER THAN TALL. 8-10'HW IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM KOTO NO ITO: THE EXTREMELY NARROW LOBES DANCE IN THE WIND! THE LIGHT GREEN SPRING LEAVES DARKEN IN THE SUMMER AND TURN YELLOW, GOLD, RED AND ORANGE IN THE FALL. 5-6'H X 3-5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM MIKAWA YATSUBUSA: A GREEN LEAF DWARF WITH SHORT STUBBY SHOOTS THAT OVERLAP GIVING IT A UNIQUE APPEARANCE. FALL COLOR IS ORANGE TO RED. 6'HW IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM MIKAZUKI: THE NARROW LOBED LEAVES HAVE PINK-BLUSH OVER WHITE WITH GREEN RETICULATION. THE COLOR HOLDS WELL THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER, TURNING A BEAUTIFUL ORANGE WITH GREEN RETICULATION. 8'H X 5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM MIZUHO BENI: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE BRILLIANT ORANGE-YELLOW EDGED WITH BRIGHT CRIMSON FROM PINK BUD SHEATHS. THE SUMMER LEAVES ARE GREEN WITH RED EDGES CHANGING TO RED AND ORANGE IN THE FALL. THE WINTER IS HIGHLIGHTED BY THE RED TWIGS AT THE BRANCH ENDS. 8-10'H X 6-8'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM MOONFIRE: FAST GROWING WITH LONG LASTING RED FOLIAGE AND FULL SUN TOLERANCE. THE SPRING LEAVES ARE DARK PURPLE TURNING RED IN THE SUMMER AND BRIGHT FIERY RED IN THE FALL. THE LEAVES WILL STAY PURPLER IN THE SUMMER IF PLANTED IN THE SHADE. 12-14'H X 10-12'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM NISHIKI GAWA: THE PINE LIKE BARK BECOMES MORE PRONOUNCED WITH AGE. THE BRIGHT GREEN LEAVES TURN RED-GOLD IN THE FALL. 15'HW.

ACER PALMATUM OMURAYAMA: THE DEEPLY DIVIDED GREEN LEAVES TURN GOLD AND RED IN THE FALL. UPRIGHT AND SPREADING. 20'HW.

ACER PALMATUM ORANGE DREAM: IN SPRING, THE FINELY DIVIDED LEAVES EMERGE CHARTREUSE WITH A BOLD ORANGE-RED MARGIN. THE SUMMER LEAVES ARE SOLID GREEN TURNING A RICH PERSIMMON-RED IN THE FALL. 15-20'H X 18'W.

ACER PALMATUM ORIDO NISHIKI: VARIEGATED. THE SPRING LEAVES HAVE COLORS RANGING FROM PINK, GREEN, RED, CREAM AND WHITE. THE FALL COLOR IS REDDISH MAROON. 15-18'HW.

ACER PALMATUM OSAKAZUKI: THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS OLIVE-ORANGE, TURNING BRIGHT GREEN IN THE SUMMER AND BRILLIANT CRIMSON IN THE FALL. 20'H X 25'W.

ACER PALMATUM OSHIO BENI: BRILLIANT RED-ORANGE SPRING LEAVES TURN GREEN IN LATE JUNE AND THEN ORANGE-RED AGAIN IN THE FALL. 15'H X 18'W.

ACER PALMATUM PEACHES AND CREAM: VARIEGATED. THE SPRING LEAVES ARE CREAM WITH ROSE RED AND GREEN RETICULATION TURNING YELLOW IN THE FALL. GROWS IN A SHRUBBY HABIT. 10'H X 20'W.

ACER PALMATUM PEVE STANLEY: THE SMALL PURPLE RED LEAVES APPEAR TO BE 3 DIMENSIONAL. FALL COLOR IS ORANGE TO RED. 8'H X 4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM PIXIE: SIMILAR TO BLOODGOOD BUT MUCH SMALLER IN SIZE. THE BRIGHT RED SPRING LEAVES TURN DEEP RED IN THE SUMMER AND SCARLET TO FIERY RED IN THE FALL. 5-7'HW IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM RHODE ISLAND RED: THE BRIGHT RED SPRING LEAVES DARKEN IN THE SUMMER AND TURN ORANGE TO RED IN THE FALL. AN UPRIGHT, VERY DENSE AND COMPACT HABIT. 6'HW.

ACER PALMATUM RUBRUM: THE LEAVES ARE GREEN-RED THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER AND FIERY ORANGE IN THE FALL. THE ARCHING SHOOTS GROW INTO A MOUNDING FORM. 6'H X 10'W.

ACER PALMATUM RUBY STARS: THE SMALL, STAR SHAPED LEAVES ARE PINKISH RED IN THE SPRING, RUBY RED IN THE SUMMER AND BRILLIANT YELLOW AND RED IN THE FALL. 3'H X 1.5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM SANGO KAKU: THE YOUNG BRANCHES HAVE BRILLIANT CORAL BARK THAT INTENSIFIES IN THE WINTER. THE LIGHT GREEN LEAVES WITH RED MARGINS TURN GOLD IN THE FALL. 15-20'HW.

ACER PALMATUM SCOLOPENDRIFOLIUM: THE FINE, LONG SLENDER LEAVES ARE MAROON IN THE SPRING, BRIGHT GREEN IN THE SUMMER AND BURNT REDDISH ORANGE IN THE FALL. 12'HW.

ACER PALMATUM SHAINA: BRIGHT RED SPRING LEAVES TURN DEEP MAROON-RED IN THE SUMMER AND BRILLIANT SCARLET IN THE FALL. DWARF AND COMPACT. 6-8'H X 8-10'W.

ACER PALMATUM SHARP'S PYGMY: THE SMALL GREEN LEAVES HAVE PURPLE OVERTONES, TURNING ORANGE TO RED IN THE FALL. 4-5'H X 3-4'W.

ACER PALMATUM SHIGURE BATO: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE LIGHT GREEN WITH RED EDGES. THE FALL COLOR IS GOLD AND CRIMSON. 5'H X 3'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM SHISHIGASHIRA: THE HEAVILY CURLED LEAVES ARE GREEN IN THE SPRING AND SUMMER, TURNING PURPLE RED WITH ORANGE-RED IN THE FALL. 12-15'H X 8-10'W.

ACER PALMATUM SHOJO NOMURA: THE DARK PURPLE-RED LEAVES TURN FIERY ORANGE-RED IN THE FALL. 10'H X 15'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM SKEETER'S BROOM: UNUSUAL TWIGGY GROWTH WITH SMALL LEAVES THAT ARE BRIGHT RED IN THE SPRING TURNING DARK RED IN THE SUMMER. FALL COLOR IS BRILLIANT SCARLET. 6-8'H X 3-4'W.

ACER PALMATUM SUMINAGASHI: THE NARROW LOBED FOLIAGE IS DEEP PURPLE-RED IN THE SPRING AND SUMMER, TURNING BRONZE-GREEN TO GREEN-RED AND FINALLY BRIGHT CRIMSON IN THE FALL. 14-16'HW.

ACER PALMATUM TENNY NO HOSHI: THE SMALL WAVY LEAVES ARE A STRONG LIGHT GREEN WITH PINK AND CREAM EDGES. FALL COLOR IS GOLDEN YELLOW. VASE SHAPED AND DENSELY BRANCHED. 10-15'HW.

ACER PALMATUM TROMPENBURG: THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS DARK PURPLE, ALMOST CHOCOLATE COLORED CHANGING TO BRILLIANT SCARLET RED IN THE FALL. FAST GROWING AND VASE SHAPED. 15-18'H X 10-14'W.

ACER PALMATUM TSUCHIGUMO: THE SPRING LEAVES ARE RUSTY RED SOON CHANGING TO VIVID GREEN THROUGHOUT THE SUMMER. THE FALL COLOR IS BRIGHT GOLD WITH CRIMSON EDGES. THE LEAVES GROW IN A DOWNWARD CRINKLE. SEMI-DWARF. 8'H X 4'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM TSUKUSHIGATA: THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS BLACK RED WITH GREEN RETICULATION. THE SUMMER COLOR IS RED CHANGING TO BRONZE THEN GREEN WITH SCARLET SAMARAS. THE FALL COLOR IS FIERY RED AND THE GREEN BARK GIVES NICE WINTER INTEREST. 5-7'H X 3-5'W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM TSUMA GAKI: “RED FINGERNAILS”. THE BRIGHT RED TIPS ON LIGHT GREEN ALMOST YELLOW SPRING LEAVES FADE TO DARK GREEN IN THE SUMMER. THE FALL COLOR IS BRIGHT RED. PREFERS PARTIAL SHADE. 5-7’H X 4-6’W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM UENO YAMA: VERY EARLY FOLIATION, WITH THE BRIGHT YELLOW SPRING LEAVES CHANGING TO LIGHT GREEN IN THE SUMMER. FALL COLOR IS VERY NICE YELLOW ORANGE. 10-12’H X 6-8’W.

ACER PALMATUM UKIGUMO: “FLOATING CLOUD”. THE SPRING FOLIAGE IS SPECKLED PINK AND WHITE. THE PINK FADES IN THE SUMMER LEAVING GREEN AND DUSTY WHITE. THE FALL COLOR IS ORANGE. 10-12’H X 8-10’W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM UKON (AOYAGI): THE LIGHT GREEN LEAVES TURN VIVID YELLOW IN THE FALL. THE TWIGS AND BRANCHES TURN CORAL YELLOW-GREEN IN THE WINTER. 7’H X 3’W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM VAN DEN AKKER: THE ORANGE RED LEAVES PERSIST INTO THE SUMMER, CHANGING YELLOW TO ORANGE IN THE FALL. 2’H X 4’W IN 10 YEARS.

ACER PALMATUM VILLA TARANTO: THE SPRING LINEARILOBUM LEAVES ARE ORANGE-RED, GRADUALLY TURNING GREEN WITH A LIGHT PURPLE-BRONZE OVERTONE. THE FALL COLOR IS BRILLIANT YELLOW AND ORANGE. 10’HW.
